

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A HOUSING COMMISSION FOR THE TOWNSHIP OF REPUBLIC, MARQUETTE COUNTY, MICHIGAN

WHEREAS, insanitary and unsafe inhabited dwelling accommodations exist in the TOWNSHIP OF REPUBLIC, MARQUETTE County, Michigan;

WHEREAS, there is a shortage of safe and sanitary dwelling accommodations in the said TOWNSHIP of REPUBLIC, available to persons who lack the amount of income which is necessary to enable them, without financial assistance, to live in decent, safe and sanitary dwellings without over-crowding; and

WHEREAS, it is for the public interest that a housing commission be created in the said TOWNSHIP of REPUBLIC, MARQUETTE County, Michigan.


NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOWNSHIP OF REPUBLIC ORDAINS:

Section 1. Pursuant to Act No. 18, Michigan Public Acts of 1933, Extra Session, as amended, a commission is hereby created in and for the TOWNSHIP of REPUBLIC, MARQUETTE County, Michigan, to be known as the "REPUBLIC TOWNSHIP Housing Commission".

Section 2. The TOWNSHIP Supervisor of the said TOWNSHIP of REPUBLIC is hereby directed to appoint the members of the said REPUBLIC TOWNSHIP Housing Commission as soon as possible after this ordinance shall take effect.

Section 3. The TOWNSHIP Clerk is hereby directed to cause this ordinance to be published as soon as possible in Marquette Mining Journal, circulated in the (local newspapers) TOWNSHIP of REPUBLIC, MARQUETTE County, Michigan, and to be posted in three public places throughout the TOWNSHIP of REPUBLIC.
