ORDINANCE NO. 5

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES, SNOWTRAVELLERS, AND SIMILAR VEHICLES UPON THE SIDEWALKS, STREETS AND ALLEYS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF REPUBLIC AND PROVIDING PENALTIES OF THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Township of Republic Ordains:

Sec. 1. Hereafter it shall be unlawful at any time, for any Person, Firm or Corporation, its Officers, Agents, or Employees to operate, maintain, run or drive a snowmobile, snow traveller or similar self-propelled device and mechanism used for travelling upon and in the snow, upon the sidewalks, streets, or in the cemetery. Alleys may be used from 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.

Sec. 2. Any Person, Firm or Corporation violating the provisions of this Ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof, before a Court of competent jurisdiction, be punished by a fine of not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, together with the cost of prosecution, and in default of the payment of such fine and cost, shall be imprisoned in the County Jail for a term not exceeding Ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Court.

Sec. 3. This ORDINANCE shall be deemed to be immediately necessary for the preservation of the Public Peace, Health and Safety, and shall take immediate effect.
