

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF REPUBLIC  
TO PROTECT SAFETY AND HEALTH OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC

Ordinance Number ~~16~~ 16

Section I.

The Township Board may, by a majority vote, declare any area, either public or private, to be unsafe for public travel or occupancy whenever the Township Board has reasonable cause to believe that persons may suffer bodily injury or harm or danger because of the use of explosives <sup>or blasting</sup> in close proximity to said area or for any other reason.

Section II.

By a majority vote of the township board said area shall be declared to be "Unsafe area" and the township board shall cause notices to that effect to be posted in the area so declared.

Section III.

The Township Board may prohibit persons from entering an unsafe area by use of fences or other means to protect the general health, safety and welfare of the public.

Section IV.

The Township Board may, in its discretion, issue such orders for the permanent vacancy of certain areas declared to be unsafe areas within such times as the board may prescribe.

Section V.

If any person, partnership, co partnership, firm, corporation either public or private, or any other firm or organization whatsoever shall be prohibited from the reasonable use and enjoyment of his or their premises and property because of the use of explosives, <sup>or blasting</sup> he or they shall be entitled to maintain an action therefore against the persons so prohibiting his reasonable use and enjoyment of his premises and property and shall be in entitled to treble damages.

Section VI.

If any section or provisions or part thereof in this ordinance shall be adjudged and declared invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not effect the validity of the ordinances as a whole or of any other section or provision or part hereof.

Section VII.

This ordinance is ordered to take effect immediately.
