5) Old Business:

- a) Camper Ordinance: Discussion ensued. Several suggestions made. It will be reworked and brought to next meeting for further action.
- b) Perch Lake Rezoning: More discussion. Area was erroneously zoned resource production years ago. When the area was subdivided for residential lots, no change was made. Zoning Administrator will work up document to recommend this change to the Twp. Board and bring it to our next meeting for our action.
