Draft Minutes of the June 10, 2019 Regular Planning Commission meeting.

- 6) The **minutes for the May 20, 2019 meeting** were approved after a motion by T. Sandblom, supported by J. Ison.

### **7) REPORTS:**

- Zoning administrator reported applications were down for new construction. One fence permit since last month. Multiple marihuana conference calls. Also reported the Pop Shop will be demolished and replaced, possibly starting next week.
- The Recreation Committee reported a subcommittee comprised of two members from the rec committee and two members of the Historical Society would be meeting at the Township Hall at 1 p.m. on the 25<sup>th</sup> to discuss the future use of the Old Bank Building. All clubs will be invited to display. The Rec Committee will not meet for the summer. Next meeting is in September  
Further, the TIFA has requested permits for a small boat launch on the northeast quadrant of the M-95/County Road LG intersection.  
And, the gates are down at the dam.
- The PC Chair had no formal report

- A brief status update was given on the Master Plan. One additional document just been received from Marquette County. The Zoning Administrator will arrange for the next step for implementation/adoption of the Plan
- A discussion was held on the impact of Medical Marihuana Providers and their facilities on the Zoning. In specific, the use of Shipping Containers as accessory structures.


### **9) NEW BUSINESS:**
